Graffiti Watch, the San Francisco Anti-Graffiti Program, is a citywide volunteer effort to prevent and remove graffiti from street furniture such as poles, mailboxes, signal boxes and other public property that taggers deface. The program's goal is to keep San Francisco's streets graffiti-free through community involvement and enforcement.

The San Francisco Department of Public Works (DPW), working with a citywide Graffiti Taskforce, the Police Department and community leaders, empowers residents to take ownership of their neighborhoods. DPW supplies the training and tools and the community takes charge from there.

When you join the San Francisco Anti-Graffiti Program, you are joining an elite team! You will commit to an area around where you live or work for a period of two years and will be responsible for keeping the area free of graffiti. - A badge that empowers me to do my job.
- A vest to identify me as a committed volunteer.
- After one year, and if I adopt a series of blocks, I may receive an electric cart to get around my district. (Volunteers must be insured and be willing to assume utility costs.)
- Certificate of Appreciation from the Mayor's Office and the Board of Supervisors.
